

Utility Rates Will Increase Starting April 1st:

Trash Collection: \$35.00/ month per unit

Residential Sewer: \$27.75/ month per unit

Out of City Residential Sewer: \$41.65/ month per unit

Commercial Sewer: \$36.80/ month and \$3.50 per thousand gallons

Residential & Commercial Water: \$12.50/ month with Volume Rate at \$5.25 per thousand gallons

Out of City Water: \$16.50/ month and \$7.25 per thousand gallons
