Utility Rate Changes Effective April 1st, 2025

Residential : Water \$12.50 minimum charge for first 2,000 gallons, then \$5.25 per additional 1,000 gal. Sewer \$27.75, Sanitation \$35.00.

Commercial: Water \$12.50 min, \$5.25 per additional 1,000 gal, Sewer \$36.80 minimum charge, Sewer Volume Rate \$3.50 per 1,000 gal

Outside City Limits Residential and Commercial: Water Minimum charge \$16.50, \$7.25 per additional 1000 gal, Sewer \$41.65
