Did You Know?

Getting a tattoo from an unlicensed artist can put your health at serious risk. Unlicensed tattooists may not follow proper hygiene practices, increasing the chance of infections, blood borne diseases like Hepatitis B or C, and improperly healed tattoos. Licensed artists working in licensed facilities are required to meet strict health and safety standards to protect clients and ensure a clean, professional environment.
