

ORDINANCE NO. 191

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND RE-ENACT
ORDINANCE NO. 99, SECTION 9, APPEARING
IN THE MILLS MUNICIPAL CODE AS SECTION
13.08.080, ENTITLED "ATTACHMENT EXPENSES -
MAINTENANCE".

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF
MILLS, WYOMING.

SECTION 1. All materials for each and every hook-on attachment to
the main sewer line shall be furnished by the user of the installation and shall
remain the responsibility of the user. Maintenance, repair and replacements
of all private sewers, to include the hook-on attachment to the main line and
the private line to the user facility, shall be the responsibility and shall be at
the expense of the users. The maintenance of main sewer lines, exclusive
of the hook-on attachment and private line as aforesaid, shall be done by the
Town and at Town expense.

SECTION 2. FORMER ORDINANCE REPEALED. Section 9 of Ordinance
99, and any and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are
hereby repealed.
