BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING.

SECTION 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 114, 1957, be amended to read as follows:

> SECTION 2. PETTY THEFT -- PENALTY. Whoever shall steal, take and carry, lend or drive away property of another, on conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars.

SECTION 2. FORMER ORDINANCE REPEALED. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 114, and any and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
