

ORDINANCE NO. 218

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE BURNING OF
GARBAGE, WASTE, ETC, AND PROVIDING FOR
VIOLATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS,
WYOMING.

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to burn or
cause to be burned any garbage, waste, packing material, trash, dis-
carded boxes or other materials, outside of an incinerator, approved
by the Town Fire Marshal, within the Town limits of the Town of Mills,
without having first obtained written permission from the Town Fire
Marshal. The Town Fire Marshal shall grant such permission if, in his
opinion, the burning of the above-described materials can be accomplished
without danger to adjoining property or undue contamination to the air
in the vicinity. The Town shall not be held to assume any liability
by reason of having granted permission to burn any of the materials
mentioned herein if such burning should cause damage to other person's
property. The permission granted shall be valid for only forty-eight
(48) hours from the time of issuance.

SECTION 2. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance
shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof
shall be fined not more than One-hundred (\$100.00) dollars plus costs.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of any Ordinances in conflict
herewith are hereby repealed.
