ORDINANCE NO. 242

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND RE-ENACT SECTION NOS. 2, 3, 6, 7 and 9 OF ORDI-NANCE NO. 160, 1966, APPEARING IN THE MILLS MUNICIPAL CODE AS SECTION NOS. 13.04.020, 13.04.030, 13.04.060, 13.04.070 and 13.04.090, ENTITLED FEE FOR TURNING ON WATER--COMPLIANCE WITH REGULATIONS; WATER MAINS TO BE TAPPED BY WATER COMMISSIONER ONLY--FEES; RATES FOR HOUSEHOLDERS; IRRIGATION RATE FOR HOUSEHOLDERS; AND RATES FOR INDUSTRIAL CONCERNS, RESPECTIVELY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING.

SECTION 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 160, 1966, be amended to read as follows:

Complaince with regulations. Any person intending to consume water from the Mills municipal water system shall notify the water department office of his intention and of his desire to have the water turned into the individual lines from which he expects to draw it, and shall pay the clerk at the office a fee of Two (\$2.00) Dollars for the service and shall thereafter pay to the town, the regular water rental fee, as hereinafter established, and shall in all manner be subject to, and shall abide by all rules and regulations established by the town concerning the dispensation of water from the municipal water system and/or the consumers of such water.

SECTION 2. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 160, 1966, be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. Water mains to be tapped by
water commissioner only--Fees. Any person desiring
the tapping of a water main belonging to the town,

for the purpose of attaching an individual line thereto, shall be required to pay to the water department office, in addition to the fee for turning the water on, as specified in Section 2, a fee of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars for a 3/4" water main tap; Thirty-Five (\$35.00) Dollars for a 1" water main tap; Ninety-Five (\$95.00) Dollars for a 2" water main tap; One Hundred Seventy-Five (\$175.00) Dollars for a 3" water main tap, together with payment to the town for the actual cost plus 10% of materials used. All persons other than the water commissioner or other persons expressly authorized by him or by other competent authority to do so, are hereby prohibited from tapping, or in any way making any opening in, or connection to, or from otherwise disturbing, molesting, or altering any water main or other line, belonging to the town.

SECTION 3. That Section 6 of Ordinance No. 160, 1966, be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 6. Rates for householders. Unless and until otherwise established by ordinance
of the council, the water rental fee, for householders shall be Seven and 50/100 (\$7.50) Dollars
for each quarter of a year, the fee to be considered payment in full for four thousand five
hundred (4,500) gallons of water, or any part
thereof, consumed by such householder, and all
water, over and above the minimum quantity, shall
be charged for at the rate of twenty cents per
thousand gallons.

SECTION 4. That Section 7 of Ordinance No. 160, 1966, entitled "Irrigation rate for householders" shall be deleted

in its entirety.

SECTION 5. That Section 9 of Ordinance No. 160, 1966, be amended to read as follows:

The water rental rate for industrial concerns and for those generally who consume water for other than household or moderate irrigation purposes, and who employ piping and meters larger than the customary three-quarter (3/4") inch for the conveyance and measuring of water, shall be Twelve (\$12.00) Dollars for each quarter year, which amount shall be considered as payment in full for each nine thousand (9,000) gallons of water, or any part thereof, consumed in any one quarter, and all water, over and above the aforesaid quantity consumed by a concern in any one quarter, shall be paid for at the rate of twenty-five cents per thousand gallons.

SECTION 6. FORMER ORDINANCES REPEALED. Sections 2, 3, 6, 7 and 9 of Ordinance No. 160, 1966, and any and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
