

ORDINANCE NO. 285

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE THE OFFENSE OF CARRYING  
A CONCEALED FIREARM OR OTHER DEADLY WEAPONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF  
MILLS, WYOMING.

SECTION 1.

Every person not being a law enforcement officer or  
other person who is authorized under §6-11-103 Wyoming  
Statutes Annotated (1977), who shall wear or carry any dirk,  
switch knife, pistol, bowie knife, dagger, sword-in-cane or  
any other dangerous or deadly weapon concealed, shall be  
guilty of a misdemeanor and fined in any sum not exceeding  
One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars. The definition of "Law  
Enforcement Officer" in §6-11-103 WSA (1977) is incorporated  
herein and by this reference made a part hereof.

SECTION 1.

REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES

Any and all ordinances, or parts of ordinances in  
conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
