

ORDINANCE NO. 293

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND REINACT
PART OF SECTION 2, ORDINANCE 222
1973 APPEARING IN THE MILLS MUNICIPAL CODE
AS SECTION 1.01.115 TO ELIMINATE IMPRISONMENT
AS A PENALTY UPON CONVICTION OF
A VIOLATION OF A MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the governing body of the Town of
Mills, Wyoming:

SECTION I

That a part of Section 2, Ordinance 222, 1973 appearing
as 1.01.115 Penalty upon conviction, which presently reads,
"Upon conviction by the Municipal Court of a violation of
any Ordinance of the Town of Mills, the Municipal Court
shall have the power and authority of imposing fines not
exceeding Two Hundred (\$200.00) dollars or imprisonment not
exceeding three (3) months for each violation of a Town
Ordinance", is hereby amended to read as follows:

Upon conviction by the Municipal Court of a violation
of any Ordinance of the Town of Mills, the Municipal Court
shall have the power and authority of imposing fines not
exceeding Two Hundred (\$200.00) dollars.

SECTION II

REPEAL OF CONFLICTION ORDINANCES

It is the intent of this Ordinance to eliminate imprison-
ment as a form of punishment or penalty upon conviction of a
violation of a Municipal Ordinance and to that extent any
and all Ordinances or parts of Ordinance in conflict herewith
are hereby specifically repealed.




