

ORDINANCE NO. 300

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TAX LEVY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING FEBRUARY 28, 1982.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING.

SECTION 1. THAT THE AMOUNT OF TAXES TO MEET THE EXPENDITURES OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, WYOMING, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MARCH 1, 1981, AND ENDING FEBRUARY 28, 1982, SHALL BE SIX (6) MILLS, KNOWN AS THE GENERAL TAX.

ORDINANCE NO. 298

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE
POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC OR
ALCOHOLIC MALT BEVERAGES IN
AN OPEN CONTAINER IN ANY OPEN
SPACE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF
MILLS, WYOMING.

SECTION 1.

It shall be unlawful for any person to possess alco-
holic or alcoholic malt beverages in an open container in
any open space in the Town of Mills, unless a permit is
obtained from the Town Council of the Town of Mills.

A. "Open space" is defined as any street, alley,
public way, park, sidewalk, public or private parking lot
set aside for business use or in any motor vehicles.

SECTION 2.

Repeal of conflicting Ordinances, any and all Ordi-
nances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are
hereby repealed.
