

ORDINANCE NO. 311

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE POLICE OFFICERS TO ISSUE CITATIONS FOR ANY VIOLATION OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF MILLS THAT ARE ESTABLISHED BY THE POLICE JUSTICE AS BAILABLE OFFENSES, PROVIDING FOR THE CONTENTS OF THE CITATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, NATRONA COUNTY, WYOMING.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Town Council of the Town of Mills that there is a need to eliminate the automatic taking of persons into custody for violations on bailable offenses.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1:

That the police officers will have the sole discretion whether to issue a misdemeanor citation pursuant to this Ordinance or make an arrest and follow the booking-in procedure at the County Jail for all offenses listed by the Police Justice as bailable offenses. The misdemeanor citations shall be on a form established by the Police Chief. The misdemeanor citations shall meet the minimum standards for Complaint as required by law and shall be kept and accounted for as are the uniform traffic citations.

SECTION 2:

All Ordinances or Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby specifically repealed.

PASSED, APPROVED and ADOPTED on THIRD and FINAL READING the 20 day of May, 1981.
