

ORDINANCE NO. 316

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE JURISDICTIONAL LIMITS OF THE POLICE COURT, TO RENAME THE POLICE COURT AND POLICE JUDGE TO MUNICIPAL COURT, MUNICIPAL JUDGE.

WHEREAS, the State of Wyoming has authorized the cities and towns to increase the maximum sentences imposable by the municipal judges for violation of town ordinances; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Wyoming has renamed the police court and police judges as municipal court, municipal judges.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF MILLS, as follows:

SECTION 1:

The police court and police judge be renamed to be municipal court and municipal judge.

SECTION 2:

That the maximum fine imposable by the municipal court for all offenses in the Town shall be \$750.00 per offense, plus court costs not exceeding \$10.00 per offense.
