

ORDINANCE 360

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 312, ZONING, ADOPTED JUNE 1, 1981, CHANGING THE DISTRICT DESIGNATION OF LOTS 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, BLOCK 8, TOPAZ ADDITION, TO THE TOWN OF MILLS FROM DEVELOPING INDUSTRIAL TO PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT.


WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Mills has initiated the proposed zone change and has after review by the Planning and Zoning Board and public hearing, determined that the proposed zone change will provide for a better use of the land, and is in keeping with the proposed land use plan and land use policies of the Town.

THEREFORE, the Zoning District designation of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, Block 8, Topaz Addition is hereby changed from Developing Industrial to Planned Unit Development.




